- I can read and write numbers up to 9 999.
- I can identify the place value of digits (ones, tens, hundreds, thousands).
- I can compare and order numbers up to 9 999.
- I can round numbers to the nearest 10, 100, or 1 000.
- I can tell if a number is odd or even.
- I can add numbers up to 4 digits with regrouping.
- I can subtract numbers up to 4 digits with regrouping.
- I can multiply a 2-digit number by a 1-digit number.
- I can divide a 2-digit number by a 1-digit number.
- I can solve word problems using addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division.
- I can identify and continue simple number patterns.
- I can find multiples of 2, 3, 4, 5, and 10.
- I can identify factors of numbers up to 20.

🍕 Fractions

- I can identify fractions using numerator and denominator.
- I can represent fractions on a number line and with diagrams.
- I can compare fractions with the same denominator.
- I can arrange fractions in ascending and descending order.
- I can identify equivalent fractions.
- I can add fractions with like denominators.
- I can subtract fractions with like denominators.
- I can identify improper fractions and mixed numbers.
- I can find a fraction of a quantity (e.g. $\frac{3}{4}$ of 24).

- I can identify the most common value (mode) in a data set.
- I can collect, organise, and display data.

Spelling

- I can spell words with common digraphs (sh, ch, th, wh, ph).
- I can spell words with common blends (bl, cr, st, tr, gr, fl).

- I can spell words using common prefixes (re-, un-, dis-).
- I can spell words using common suffixes (-ful, -less, -ness, -ly).
- I can form plurals correctly using -s and -es.
- I can form plurals for words ending in -y (e.g. baby → babies).
- I can spell common irregular plurals (children, feet, mice).
- I can identify and spell common homophones (their/there/they're, to/too/two).
- I can spell high-frequency sight words for Standard 3.
- I can spell commonly confused words (because, friend, which, beautiful).

Punctuation

- I can use full stops, question marks, and exclamation marks correctly.
- I can use commas in a list.
- I can use apostrophes for contractions (don't, can't, it's).
- I can use apostrophes for possession (the boy's bag).
- I can punctuate dialogue using quotation marks.
- I can capitalise proper nouns, days, months, and the start of sentences.

Grammar / Usage

- I can identify common and proper nouns.
- I can identify singular and plural nouns.
- I can identify pronouns and use them correctly (I, he, she, they, we).
- I can identify action verbs and linking verbs.
- I can use present, past, and future tense verbs correctly.
- I can identify adjectives and use them to describe nouns.
- I can identify adverbs and use them to describe verbs.
- I can use conjunctions to join sentences (and, but, because, so, or).
- I can use prepositions correctly (on, in, under, beside, between).
- I can match subjects and verbs correctly.
- I can identify and form contractions.
- I can identify and use negatives correctly.
- I can identify synonyms and antonyms.
- I can identify simple homophones.
- I can use context clues to find the meaning of unknown words.
