



VISION



2010


Grade A Tutoring and Learning Centre was founded in 2010 by two graduates of the University of The West Indies. At this time, the company only provided one-onone tutoring to students.





The company was relocated to Barataria after serving the Belmont community for many years




2020

ABOUT OUR SCHOOL





At Grade A Online Primary Academy, we provide a full-time, structured learning experience for students who thrive best in a focused and supportive digital environment.

Our programme follows the Ministry of Education's curriculum, with engaging lessons in Mathematics, Language Arts, Science, and Social Studies, all taught live by qualified tutors.

We combine small-group instruction with interactive learning technology to ensure every child receives personal attention and real-time support.

Students attend daily online classes via Google Meet, complete assignments through Google Classroom, and benefit from consistent progress tracking, individual feedback, and strong parent communication.

Our full-time school is ideal for students who need a flexible yet structured education that keeps them connected, motivated, and academically strong — all from the comfort of home.



HOW WE TEACH



At Grade A Online Primary Academy, we believe technology and teaching go hand-in-hand.

Each virtual classroom is designed for live instruction, collaboration, and accountability.

We use:

- Google Classroom for daily notes, homework, and resources
- Google Meet for interactive live sessions
- Digital progress reports to track growth and guide improvement Our teachers focus on building mastery and confidence, not just grades.

Classes are small to allow individualized attention, and lessons include discussions, games, writing practice, and project-based learning — ensuring students stay engaged and excited about learning.



LOWER SCHOOL

Our online primary school is divided into upper and lower schools. The lower school refers to students from standards 1-3 while upper school refers to students from standards 4 and 5. The lower school is the foundation years where students are able to learn the basics. Once they have mastered the basics they can then move on to the upper school where they can choose the write the SEA exam.

PARENT POLICIES & GUIDELINES

(FOR GRADE A ONLINE PRIMARY ACADEMY FAMILIES)

At Grade A Online Primary Academy, we believe that education works best when parents and teachers partner together. These guidelines ensure consistency, respect, and success for every child.

Attendance & Punctuality

- Students are expected to attend all live sessions on time each day.
- Absences must be communicated to the teacher or the school WhatsApp line before class begins.
- Frequent absences without notice may affect participation grades and progress reports.

Technology & Environment

- A stable internet connection, quiet learning space, and functioning device (laptop/tablet) are required.
- Cameras should remain on during classes unless permission is given otherwise.
- Students should be seated properly and dressed neatly (no pajamas or lying in bed during sessions).

同 Homework & Assignments

- All assignments must be submitted on time via Google Classroom.
- Parents should check the platform weekly to monitor their child's progress.
- Late or incomplete work will be recorded and addressed with both the student and parent.



PARENT POLICIES & GUIDELINES

M Classroom Etiquette

- Students must be respectful, use kind language, and follow teacher instructions.
- Background noise and interruptions should be minimized.
- Parents are asked not to coach or interrupt during lessons; communication should be done privately through messages or scheduled meetings.

Communication

- All official communication should be sent through the school's WhatsApp line, email, or Google Classroom announcements.
- Teachers will respond to messages during working hours (9 AM – 4 PM, Monday to Friday).
- For urgent matters, parents may contact the administrator directly.

Payments & Refund Policy

- Term fees are due before classes begin.
- A late fee may apply after the first week of class.
- No refunds are issued after the first two weeks of the term unless special circumstances arise and are approved by the Head Educator.


